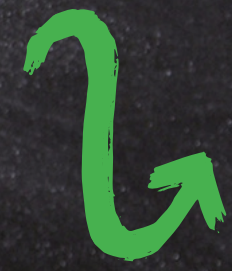
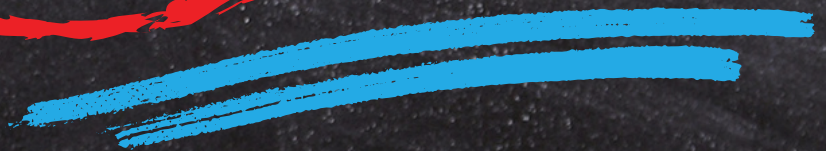
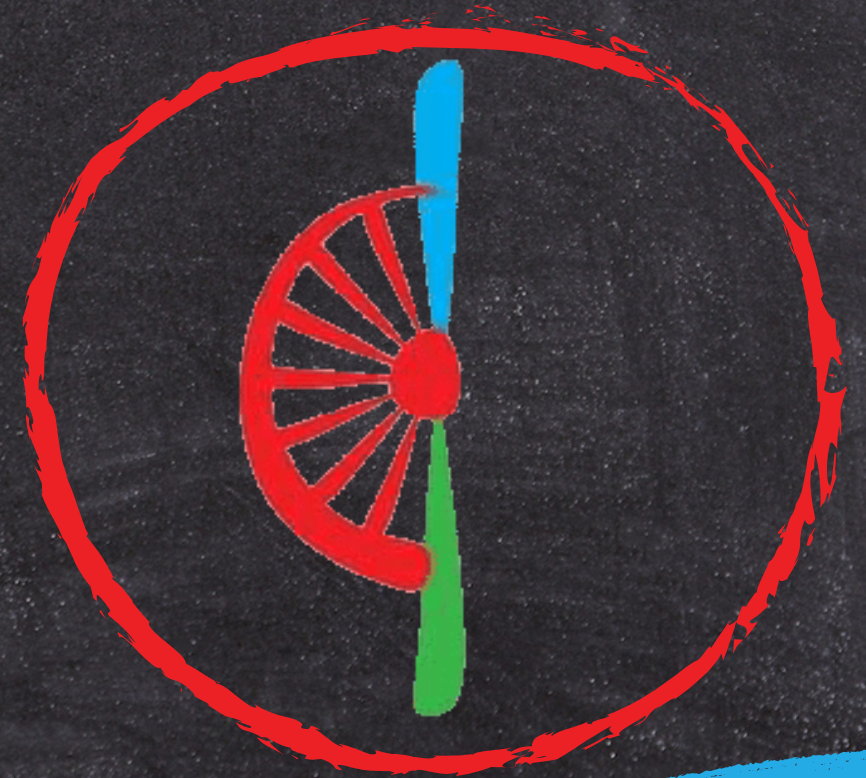

Phiren Amenca is a network of Roma and non-Roma volunteers and voluntary service organizations creating opportunities for non-formal education, dialogue and engagement, in order to challenge stereotypes and racism. Our coordination office is in Budapest, and we also have colleagues in Brussels.



WHAT DO WE DO?

Volunteering & voluntary service

Volunteering is a powerful tool of social change, as volunteers dedicate their time and energy to contribute to society. We create opportunities for young Roma and non-Roma to live and engage in local communities and projects for up to one year.

Non-Formal Education

We support dialogue, engagement and civic activism through our seminars on antigypsyism, Roma history and identities, human and civil rights activism, gender equality, online hate speech, and many more...



Advocacy

We advocate for the inclusion of the needs of young Roma in Roma-specific policies as well as mainstream youth policies; and for Roma youth representatives in decision-making processes both nationally and internationally.

SCHEDULE

Volunteering is a full-time activity, five days per week, scheduled from a minimum of 30 hours up to 38 hours per week. Some weekends, depending of the organisation's timetable, will be busy, but you will be compensated with days off. Once a week there is a home office day. Each month the volunteer accumulates 2 days off as holidays, which can be taken as longer breaks, but you need to agree on its timing with the team at least a month before.

Total duration of the activity is 360 days, starting on early October, 2023.

TRAVEL

One return travel from home to Budapest is financed by the programme. You will either buy their tickets and get reimbursed upon arrival, or Phiren Amenca buys the tickets. You will get a monthly pass for Budapest.

ACCOMMODATION

You will live in a student dormitory in Budapest in a room with bathroom and a shared kitchen. Depending on the gender of the volunteer, the room might be shared with another volunteer of the same gender.

LANGUAGE COURSE

You will have access to the Online Linguistic Support offered by the ESC programme, that will help you in learning the basics of Hungarian.

POCKET MONEY

You will receive 330€ each month for food and personal expenses. It will be given in cash in the first month, and then transferred to the volunteer's Hungarian bank account by the 5th of each month.

MENTORING AND TRAINING

You will have a personal mentor. You will attend the on-arrival and the mid-term seminar organized by the Hungarian National Agency besides the educational events organized by Phiren Amenca throughout the year.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You will be insured by the European Solidarity Corps' insurance scheme by HENNER
